O.M.E. Inc Over Childing Years

Dear Friend,

*I'm writing to you because* over the years, our supporters have helped thousands of people. It doesn't matter whether you have given \$5 or \$5,000 in the past—it has taken all of you to bring us to where we are today. As I write this, I'm reminded of a quilt, a patchwork of material sewn together into a blanket—what an apt comparison to what we do here at H.O.M.E. People whose lives have been ripped apart by homelessness, made whole again through the generosity of people like you.

People like the **father and daughter we rescued from a condemned house recently**, who lived for a year with no electricity, no water and facing significant mental health challenges. Today, they are in shelter, warm and with a safe place to rest. The work behind the scenes will include housing navigation and connecting them with their healthcare providers whom they haven't seen in more than a decade. It will also include helping them apply for a housing voucher, and when the time finally comes and they are housed, we'll assist them with furniture and household items and stay in their lives for as long as it takes to make sure they have all they need to stay on track.

A few years ago, I recall writing to you with a reflection on the proverb, "*Beyond mountains there are mountains*". It seems things are getting harder for the people we serve, and more and more families are unable to afford housing, or keep up with rising costs of heating oil and food. And while the needs are greater, so is our response.

In Maine, homelessness has doubled, and the level of crisis for people has grown. That means our work has grown. We've stepped up our navigation services, especially for households with children, and that effort is paying off. Within the last three weeks 9 people have left shelter for permanent housing.

We're also embarking on a new construction project which will provide **Permanent Supportive Housing** for families with **children experiencing homelessness**. We hope to build it on our 23-acre site in Orland. I know this has gotten your attention if you're a volunteer! There will be ample opportunities to contribute in kind to this wonderful project, which is a three-year dream in the making. *I'm writing to you* because today you have a unique opportunity to continue to write H.O.M.E.'s history with a generous gift. While we have experienced a serious economic crisis in the past, we haven't had the reach of service we have today, and with your help, H.O.M.E. can show the resiliency that has carried us through our more than half-century history. I know that, because we have **adapted to this difficult time**, and our work has come out **stronger than ever**.
